TAXES (GST)

ALL companies are responsible for collecting and remitting their own GST where applicable. If your company earns revenue greater than \$30,000.00 per year, Revenue Canada states that you must apply for a GST number. If your company makes less than this amount, it's your choice whether to get an HST number or not. If you do register a number with Revenue Canada, you can claim the GST your company pays as an input tax credit on your next tax return. Registered companies must also collect and remit GST from their ticket price.
